New ambulance station on the PCYC Falcon Street site

We are sending you this information because your home or business is located close to the PCYC on Falcon Street, North Sydney.

NSW Government has purchased the site from PCYC NSW to deliver a new Ambulance Station, marking a significant milestone in delivering a vital service which will serve communities across North Sydney and Cremorne.

The new North Sydney Ambulance Station will ensure that the local community has improved access to emergency care when and where they need it most, and that paramedics have purpose-built new facilities and modern work environments to support their vital roles.

The new ambulance station for the Lower North Shore community is in addition to the Artarmon Ambulance Superstation which opened in 2018.

Along with planning approval and design for the new station, there will be community consultation and we will keep you informed every step of the way.

The new North Sydney Ambulance Station is being delivered as part of the NSW Government's \$488.8 million NSW Ambulance Infrastructure Program and will support local paramedics to provide the best emergency medical care now and into the future.
